On January 12, 2010 at approximately 1821 hours, I was dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference a subject making threats to harm herself.

Upon arrival to the residence, I did not observe any vehicles in the drive way or near the residence. I checked the front and back yard for any possible signs of the subject. I was unable to locate anyone.

I was advised by the neighbors across the street located at [REDACTED] that they last saw the resident (later identified as [REDACTED] approximately an hour ago. [REDACTED] was last seen driving her 1999 Gold Ford Ranger ([REDACTED] to an unknown location.

[REDACTED] friend [REDACTED] (the reporter) arrived on scene. S [REDACTED] stated that her friend [REDACTED] is missing and she believes that she is endangered and suicidal. [REDACTED] s recently was broken up with by her ex-boyfriend, [REDACTED] on Sunday, January 10, 2010. [REDACTED] has been sending her mother, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] several emails and texts stating that she was going to commit suicide. [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Tittle was calling [REDACTED] cell phone in attempts to contact her.

While Cpl Tittle was calling [REDACTED] was writing a sworn written statement, I observed [REDACTED] Gold Ranger drive by the residence at approximately 1907 hours. [REDACTED] yelled out that was [REDACTED] pickup truck.

At that time, I turned my car on in attempts to catch up with [REDACTED] proceeded southbound on Adela Avenue and turned westbound on Coral Reef Drive. [REDACTED] drove into the drive way of [REDACTED] in attempts to loose me. I observed [REDACTED] turn the vehicle off and duck down in the seat. I parked my vehicle in the street and placed my spot lights onto the vehicle since [REDACTED] stated she possibly might have a gun with her. I advised dispatch that I was with the vehicle on Coral Reef Drive just [REDACTED]

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I gave loud verbal commands to [REDACTED] to exit the vehicle. [REDACTED] refused to obey my commands. [REDACTED] turned her truck on and proceeded to back towards the driver side of my marked patrol vehicle. I was standing at my passenger side door. I ran towards [REDACTED] driver side window to attempt to extract her from the vehicle. [REDACTED] n

Cpl Tittle arrived on scene at that time and was able to follow her. I got into my patrol vehicle and proceeded to catch up. The vehicle traveled northbound towards Alafaya Trail.

At the intersection of Coral Reef Dr and Alafaya Trail, [REDACTED] was behind an unknown blue four door vehicle. [REDACTED] was unable to proceed northbound on Alafaya Trail. I was able to drive around Cpl Tittle and [REDACTED] and stop my vehicle in front of [REDACTED] vehicle, as the blue vehicle drove southbound on Alafaya Trail.

I ran towards [REDACTED] y door to try and extract her from the vehicle. [REDACTED] was able to roll up the driver side window and lock the door. [REDACTED] then grabbed a 22 Caliber Rugar Long Rifle ([REDACTED] D/S Merks, Cpl Tittle and I retreated to the back of their patrol vehicles after I informed them about the rifle.

Several units arrived on the scene and shut off north and southbound traffic on Alafaya Trail. Other units arrived on scene and shut off traffic in and out of surrounding neighborhoods.

At 1910 hours, Cpl Tittle tried to make contact with [REDACTED] to surrender herself without the rifle. Cpl Tittle was able to communicate with [REDACTED] via the PA system and her cell phone. While Cpl Tittle was talking to [REDACTED] had the muzzle of the rifle under her chin. [REDACTED] would move the muzzle of the gun to the side of her head to the inside her mouth and back under her chin. At 2001 hours, [REDACTED] opened the driver side door and began to exit the vehicle slowly in attempt to surrender herself. Cpl Tittle and I detained [REDACTED] at 2002 hours.
